Corporate approval is necessary before FEA 1031 PAC can conduct a solicitation.

The *corporate representative* is the person assigned by the corporate member of FEA to be the contact with the association – that is, the person with the authority to act on behalf of the corporation, effectively acting as its agent for this purpose. As this is a designation that the individual corporate member can make, the exact title and role of the individual may vary. For example, the corporate representative could be the owner/operator of an exchange company, or the person the owner sends to work with the association on a regular basis. As a practical matter, the person signing the authorization should feel comfortable making that approval on behalf of the company. Thank you.
